CONDUCT OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT ENGINEER (ON TRAINING) / ELECTRICAL AGAINST CRA 283/14

WRITTEN TEST NOTICE (DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS)

The written test for candidates who registered themselves for the post of AE/OT(Electrical), against CRA 283/2014 is being conducted on 21.12.14 (Sunday) as per the schedule already displayed on PSPCL website (www.pspcl.in).

Following is brought to the attention of registered candidates who will appear in this written test against CRA No. 283/14:

- Admit Cards have already been sent only to registered candidates on their registered emails for written test to be held on 21.12.2014 for the above mentioned post. Only those candidates v ho possess Admit Card will be allowed to appear for the written test. However, admit card issued will be purely 'PROVISIONAL' and final eligibility would be subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria notified for the post and subject to verification of documentary proof for eligibility for the same in respect of qualifications, age, reservations etc.
- 2. All the candidates are required to bring and keep with them a proof of establishing his/her identity in the form of either a Voter Card/Driving License/PAN Card/Unique Identification Card/or any other proof that establishes candidate's identity at the time of examination. Such candidates who have not uploaded their photo while submitting online applications should bring two photographs attested by Gazetted officer at the time of examination.
- 3. A "Facilitation Centre" will be functional at only one centre as per address mentioned at PSPCL website. In case of Admit Card related query candidates are advised to visit the facilitation centre from 10.00 AM to 01.00 PM on 20th Dec, 2014 for queries related to admit card for exam/written test scheduled on 21th Dec, 2014. Candidates approaching Facilitation Centre for their query who do not get the Admit Card must bring with them two photographs attested by Gazetted officer, copy of application form, copy of Bank challan and his/her identity proof.
- 4. Candidates who have applied on-line for the post of AE/OT (Electrical) for which they do not have the required qualification as indicated in the advertisement and filled the application form by giving incorrect/incomplete/false information and Admit Card has been sent to them by on-line process, they shall be appearing at their own risk. Their application/candidature shall be liable for rejection outrightly at any stage during and/or after the process of selection.
- 5. Similarly candidates who have applied for the post of AE (OT)/ Electrical, but are having qualification/degree in Mechanical/Instrumentation & Control, Electronics & Communication, Civil (i.e. other than degree in Electrical Engineering or Electrical & Electronics Engineering), and in case admit cards to such candidates have been sent through on-line process, they shall be appearing for these posts at their own risk. In case, such cases are found later-on during selection process then candidature of such candidates for the post of AE/OT Electrical would be outrightly rejected.

- 6. Only Admit Card, photo ID shall be allowed in the examination centre. Use of Books, Notes, copying and receiving/giving assistance is not allowed. No calculator-separate or with watch, Tablets, any type of mobile phones, books, slide rules, foot rules, note books or written notes will be allowed inside the examination complex. Candidates are strictly advised not to wear any jewellery, ornaments, not to bring any kind of electronic gadgets, Bluetooth device, mobile or any other instrument which may assist him/her in cheating during the conduct of examination. Any candidate who is found copying, receiving, giving assistance or using unfair means during the exam will be disqualified and PSPCL will not be responsible for the cancellation of candidature. Therefore, all candidates shall be frisked manually as well as with suitable hand set detector for such unwanted material. Keeping this in mind, all the candidates are strictly advised to report in the examination Centre at least two hours before the start of written test.
- Candidates are advised not to bring any stationery items like Pen/Pencil, Eraser etc. in the examination centre. Pen would be provided by PSPCL.
- 8. Examination Centre shall not be indicated in the Admit Card which shall be declared / intimated to the candidates at appropriate time on the PSPCL website (www.pspcl.in).
- 9. At any stage of recruitment, if a candidate is found guilty of using unfair means, impersonating or procuring impersonation by any other person, misbehaving in the examination or resorting to any irregular/unfair means or obtaining support for his candidature by any illegal means will be disqualified, debarred permanently from any recruitment of PSPCL. Further, appropriate action would be initiated against such candidates in accordance with law, if required.
- 10. It is pertinent to mention that rest of the instructions would remain same as detailed out in CRA No.283/14 for the above mentioned post.

IMPORTANT NOTE:-

Mobile phone/ Cell Phone /Handbag /Purse /Ornaments /Electronics /Non-Electronics instrument/Goods/Articles/Pen/Pencil/Eraser etc. are strictly not allowed and are banned in the examination complex. Candidates are advised to bring only Admit Card, Photo Identity Card. Frisking will be done at entry point and during the exam. PSPCL or Examination Centre will not be responsible for keeping custody of the above prohibited items & the candidate shall be solely responsible for its safe custody outside the complex. Candidates should therefore read these instructions carefully and follow them strictly. If any of the candidate is found /possessing any of the above prohibited items inside the examination hall he/ she shall be straightaway debarred from examination on the spot, apart from action as per law may also be initiated against him/her.
