Note:- Special Instructions

1. The above Regulatory Measures are not applicable to Essential & other Exempted category of consumers fed from category 2&3 and category- 4 feeders.
2. Restricted load up to the limit of 10% of the SCD is allowed to the Arc /Induction furnace consumers on their weekly off days during off peak hours only.
3. The consumers are allowed to Import open access power on their weekly off days / restriction periods.
4. Peak load exemption charges are not to be levied for the period for which Peak Load Exemptions remained suspended.
5. The power regulatory message 115/11 dated 30.07.2012 on account of northern Grid disturbance already stands withdrawn vide message 122 / 11 dated 30.07.2012 itself.

General Instructions

1. The consumers were requested to download the information regarding peak load restrictions/ weekly off days from the PSPCL website. They were asked to visit the website of the PSPCL on regular basis in future.
2. The field officers were requested to display the relevant circulars on the notice boards of complaint centres as well as Sub Divn. Offices/Grid Sub Stations.
